Limiting Class Size

- **Due to logistical concerns, limit each grade to 40 students?**
 - ▶ We will have five classrooms capable of accommodating 40 students, at a time
- **Large class sizes will require more aides**
 - ▶ School Community Council approved \$12.5K for FY2019 aides
 - ▶ Sending to State, as soon as Board approves plan

Dear teachers and parents of students at Pioneer High School:

A person attending this school was recently diagnosed with pertussis. Pertussis (whooping cough) is a contagious disease characterized by cold symptoms such as runny nose and an irritating cough. This infection can be life-threatening in small children. In previously immunized children, teenagers and adults it frequently presents as a very persistent and sometimes severe cough that lasts for weeks. This can be spread to others, including unimmunized infants.

We do not recommend that middle school or high school contacts receive preventive antibiotics. We do advise that for the next few weeks, parents monitor their children for any symptoms that could be pertussis, as listed above. If any symptoms occur, we recommend the child be tested by their health clinician. It is important to let the clinician know that the child has been exposed to a confirmed case of pertussis.

Unfortunately, we cannot divulge the information of the person who has been identified with pertussis. An important thing to remember is that this is most likely not an isolated case; there are probably more unidentified
