    - **13 students have not registered.**

# Fire Notification System



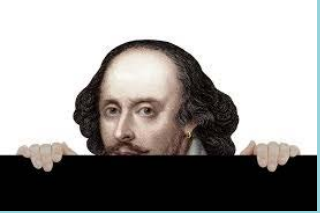
- **IT IS DONE!**
